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General description

This digital certificate recognizes personal and professional development activities undertaken by **students or staff of the Alliance or external learners** who join YUFE Entrepreneurship and Innovation ventures.

Activities will focus on identifying opportunities to improve existing solutions or develop new alternatives and on implementing positive changes and will have a strong **problem-based orientation**.

The activities have been designed to provide YUFE learners an inclusive and diverse ecosystem giving **research -and work- based opportunities**, leading to interdisciplinary and intersectoral knowledge, as well as skills acquisition.

YUFE offers personal and professional development through participation in challenges to improve existing solutions or develop new alternatives. Additionally, the Alliance fosters collaboration among research, education, industry and citizens in an **international and inter-cultural environment**.

The Professional Star is focused on **Entrepreneurship and Innovation competences**, related to the ability to identify needs or opportunities and **transform them into solutions**, for the benefit of the European citizens and regions.

Activities

A) Challenge Teams

It is a **one-term** intensive team-based process for solving social, scientific and technological challenges. Participants are gathered in teams to bring some novelty or innovation to the solution(s) working in a collaborative, multidisciplinary and multicultural environment.

B) Entrepreneurial training

C) Incubation Programme: Ideas Lab

A blended innovative program for participants who want to develop their cultural, social and business ideas. This **one-term** activity provides participants and projects a collaborative, international mentoring and feedback.

It offers a ‘learning by doing’ approach, using Lean and Design thinking methodologies. It also includes immersive experiences with start-ups and innovation events.

Workload and requirements

You need to undertake at least one Professional Star activity, with a minimum expected workload of **60 hours**.

To be rewarded, you will need to have successfully completed:

- **1 activity:** either a Challenge Teams, an Entrepreneurial Training or an Ideas Lab.
- The **Reflection Report:** a short form giving an overview of the progress you made.

- **Resources:** self-awareness, motivation, financial and economic literacy and mobilizing resources and others.
- **Ability to get into action:** taking the initiative, planning and managing, copying with risk, working with others and learning through experience.
